Troy, N. C., Tuesday, 9 A. M.

Registration of the Ministers and Delegates of the A. H. C.

The Annual Conference of the A. H. Ch. of the Carolina District was opened at 9:30 A. M. by song, followed by scripture (Rom. 12), read by Bro. S. S. Nelson. Prayer by Bro. U. L. Ruth.

Twenty-two ministers and fifteen delegates responded to

roll call.

Motion made, seconded and passed that committees be

elected by acclamation.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the following named persons serve on these respective committees:

Committee on Conference Bar: G. H. Butner, M. A.

Baldwin.

Committee on Resolutions: O. L. Ruth, Chairman, S. M. Stikeleather, W. R. Cox, W. A. Way and J. L. Crouse.

Committee for Nominating Officers: W. C. Cruse, Chairman, S. M. Stikeleather, Mrs. A. D. Luke, P. R. Thompson and O. L. Ruth.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the standing committee, namely W. R. Cox, S. S. Nelson and S. M. Stikeleather, do the work of examining ministers concerning the course of study, also candidates for license.

Committee on Evangelistic Services during Conference:

G. H. Butner, Chairman, M. A. Baldwin, W. H. Biller.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Thursday be set

aside as time for "Sunday-school Day."

Motion made, seconded and passed that Wednesday afternoon be set aside as time for election of officers for the ensuing year.

The Secretary then read the names of those to serve on

the various committees.

Motion made, seconded and passed that W. A. Way, W. R. Cox, and Mrs. A. D. Luke serve as Committee on

"Sunday-school Day" program.

Motion made, seconded, and passed that the annual reports of the various churches be read. This was set aside for a short time as a motion was made, seconded and passed that the State Superintendent deliver his annual report and recommendations at his discretion.

The reading of the annual reports by the delegates was

then heard.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Brother and Sister

P. F. Bean of Maryland be made honorary members of the Carolina District Conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Henry Horton be made an honorary member of the Carolina Conference until fully accepted as a member.

Motion made, seconded and passed to accept O. L. Ruth's resignation as a member of Nominating Committee.

Motion made, seconded and passed that J. L. Crouse fill vacancy caused by O. L. Ruth's resignation.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Conference re-

consider the time for "Sunday-cshool Day."

Motion made, seconded and passed that Conference con-

sider the reconsideration of time for "Sunday-school Day."

Motion made, seconded and passed that evangelistic serv-

ices be held Tuesday night in place of business session.

The reading of annual reports of churches was then con-

tinued.

Motion made, seconded and passed that election of officers be held Wednesday A. M. instead of Wednesday P. M.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Conference convene at 8 A. M. Wednesday.

S. S. Nelson read fifteen recommendations for the future consideration of the Conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the Treasurer of Missionary Board read his financial report.

Motion made, seconded and passed that this report be accepted after accepted by Auditing Committee.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Conference adjourn until Wednesday, 8 P. M.

Wednesday Morning, 8 O'clock

The third session of the Conference opened with song, followed by reading of Matthew 17: 1-17, by O. L. Ruth. Prayer by B. H. Vestal.

Twenty-two ministers and seventeen delegates responded to roll call.

T. A. Spencer, by consent of Conference, was excused.

Minutes of Tuesday session were read and after some correction were accepted.

Report of Nominating Committee was read.

Mrs. W. R. Cox refused to be a nominee for secretaryship. The nominating Committee retired to reconsider a nominee for secretaryship.

Committee on Resolutions reported, after which motion was made, seconded and passed that said resolutions be accepted.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the State Sup't. report at this time.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Henry Horton report his work.

Motion made, seconded and passed that report of Nominating Committee be accepted.

Motion made, seconded and passed that W. A. Way, J. F. Nance and C. A. Lain serve as tellers.

Reading of of annual reports from churches was continued. B. H. Vestal refused to report until he had a hearing with Council.

Motions made, seconded and passed that report of tellers be read, which was as follows:

Sup't., S. S. Nelson; Ass't Sup't, O. L. Ruth; Secretary, J. F. Nance; Treasurer, J. L. Crouse.

Annual Church report reading was continued

Motion made, seconded and passed that Nominating Committee's report for Councilmen be accepted.

Motion made, seconded and passed that secretary of the Conference cast the ballot for the Missionary Board: W. R. Cox, M. A. Baldwin and S. S. Nelson.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Cornie Caudle serve as our Home Missionary.

Motion made, seconded and passed that this Conference

support Sister Mattie Buchanan in China.

Report of Tellers for Councilmen: W. R. Cox, W. A. Way

and S. M. Stikeleather.

Motion made, seconded and passed that plan for Sister Mattie Buchanan's support be left with Councilmen.

Motion made, seconded and passed that J. F. Nance's resignation for secretaryship be not received.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Resolutions be

passed upon separately.

Resolution 1: Resolved that none of our pastors or evangelists shall hold a revival meeting or do Christian work of a public character in the territory of our pastors or those having charge of a Mission, without the consent and full fellowship of the pastor and the majority of his people in that territory.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this reso-

Resolution 2: Resolved that our State Superintendent be put on the same basis for his support as our pastors.

Motion made, seconded and passed that this resolution

be reconsidered.

Resolution 3: Resolved that all our circuits take steps as soon as possible to build a parsonage for its pastor.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this reso-

lution.

Resolution 4: Resolved that none of our pastors shall leave his charge to do evangelistic work or anything that takes him away from his charge without supplying his pulpit in his absence to the satisfaction of the Church which he serves.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution.

Resolution 5: Resolved that no pastor shall leave a part or all of his circuit without full knowledge of the State Superintendent, and that none of our preachers shall accept a pastorate thus left without consulting the State Superintendent.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution.

Resolution 6: Resolved that since this Conference has taken the support of Sister Mattie Buchanan, and fallen short in her support, that the amount which is deficient be raised among our churches, and forwarded to her, and her support for this year be raised also.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution.

Resolution 7: Resolved that the State Council shall out-

line the work of the State Superintendent.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution.

Resolution 8: Resolved that the placing of pastors on the different charges shall be subject to the confirmation of the State Council.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution.

Resolution 9. Resolved that this Conference appoint a

committee to confer with Henry Horton concerning his work and report to the Conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution. Resolution 10: Resolved that our pastors and delgates emphasize the importance of keeping a closer record of their financial business concerning the Church.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution. Motion made, seconded and passed that W. R. Cox and S. M. Stikeleather confer with Henry Horton as to his work

in South America.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the financial report of Church Extension Fund be read. This was approved. Motion made, seconded and passed that this Church Ex-

tension Fund be a law of this Conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed that State Sup't see that the pastors are doing their best in carrying out the resolutions passed at Conference.

Resolution 2 was reconsidered. Reconsideration was as

follows:

(a) Resolved that the State Superintendent meet the Advisory Board of each church, call a meeting of themselves and decide as nearly as they can what their pastor shall receive per month, and appoint a Finance Committee to see that the decided amount comes up.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting (a) resolu-

tion.

(b) Resolved that the State Council shall decide upon the amount that the State Superintendent shall receive and this amount apportioned among the pastors and Evangelists to be raised and sent to the State Treasurer each month.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting (b) resolution. Motion made, seconded and passed to adjourn until 1 P. M.

Wednesday Afternoon

Song, "I Believe" opened the fourth session of Conference. B. H. Barger read the scripture lesson. Prayer by W. G.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the annual reports

of the Sunday-schools be read.

Resolution 1: Resolved that the Conference set aside Wednesday evening's service for the purpose of considering the different phases of Sunday school work instead of holding religious service.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution.

Resolution 2: Resolved that this Conference elect a Sunday-school Board, consisting of three members, who shall look after the interests of Sunday-school work in our conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this resolution. Motion made, seconded and passed electing S. M. Stikeleather, W. R. Cox and Mrs. A. D. Luke to serve as Sunday-school Board.

Resolution 3: Resolved that the Sunday-schools of our Conference take a greater interest in co-operating with other Sunday-schools in the Township and County meetings and conventions.

The motion for adopting this resolution was lost.

Motion made, seconded and passed that State Sup't read his recommendations.

Sunday-school Program for evening's session was then read.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Sup't's report of

the morning be accepted.

Believing them to be to the glory of God, the interest of His kingdom and beneficial to the International Apostolic Holiness Church in Carolina and Virginia District, we submit the following recommendations:

(1) That there be a Sunday-school Board elected to look after the interests of the Sunday-school work in the Carolina and Virginia District, working when necessary, in co-operation with the Dist. supt. and Dist. Council.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 1.

(2) That there shall be action taken in regard to securing a systematic way of raising foreign missionary money. Also that the money be sent through the Conference Missionary Board.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 2.

(3) That the Conference recommend that all members tithe and that the tithe be paid into the Church treasury and handled as directed by the Church Board.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 3.

(4) That a reasonable amount be agreed upon by each Church for the support of its pastor. Not an assessment, but raised by free-will offerings. The Church Board seeing that this amount goes to the pastor regularly.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 4.

(5) That the support of Sister Mattie Buchanan be taken

up in full and sent to her in time to reach her at beginning of each quarter. Also that resolutions be drafted asking the Bi-ennial Assembly to take over the work of Brother Monroe in China.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting reccomendation 5.

Motion made, seconded and passed electing S. S. Nelson, W. R. Cox and S. M. Stikeleather to draft resolutions asking the Bi-enniel Assembly to take over the work of Brother Munroe in China.

Recommendation 6: That a committee be elected to confer with Henry Horton in regard to the taking over of his work in South America by this Conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this recommendation.

Motion made, seconded and pased electing W. R. Cox and S. M. Stikeleather to confer with Henry Horton in regard to the taking over of his work in South America by this Conference.

(7) That a roll call be made of the churches ascertaining the amount each Church or circuit has paid into the Conference Loan Fund and that a record of this roll call be printed in the minutes.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 7.

(8) That the resolution in regard to the Loan Fund be amended in such a way as to allow the interest to be charged on all money loaned and that the interest be set apart in a separate fund for the support of the permanently disabled ministers of this Conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this recom-

mendation.

(9) That the District Supt. be allowed to give examinations to any of the licensed ministers any time during the Conference year and return same for entry on the examining grade books.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting this recom-

mendation.

(10) That a Board of Education be elected by the Conference to forward the interests of Education.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 10.

(11) That care be taken to choose efficient officers to serve on local church boards.

Montion made, seconded and passed adopting recommendation 11.

(12) That a movement be urged for the opening of missions in a number of needy cities in this district.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 12.

(14) That ministers and church secretaries be implored to keep a correct record of all business actions pertaining to their work.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 14.

(15) That pastors be recommended not to neglect visiting members, also non members in vicinity of their charge.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommen-

dation 15.

(16) That arrangements be made for the owning and

operating of the Official Church paper.

Motion made, seconded and passed to amend this recommendation by changing "the official paper," to "an official paper."

Motion made, seconded and passed to accept this recommendation with an amendment of appointing a committee to form resolutions to take to the General Assembly.

Motion made, seconded and passed electing S. S. Nelson,

S. M. Stikeleather and O. L. Ruth as the committee.

(17) That this Conference approve or disapprove of the opening of the Beulah Bible School and take actions accordingly.

Motion made, seconded and passed adopting recommenda-

tion 17.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Trustees of Beulah Bible School be conferred with concerning what it needed.

Motion made, seconded and passed electing Mrs. A. D. Luke, M. A. Baldwin and W. C. Cruse, committee to look after this.

Motion made, seconded and passed that someone who is not likely to go to the Bi-ennial Assembly be elected to go.

Motion made, seconded and passed to rescind Resolution 2.

Motion made, seconded and passed to adjourn until 7:30 P. M.

Wednesday Evening

The fifth session of Conference convened at 7:30 by singing. Prayer by C. A. Ludwick was followed by a most gracious outpouring of the Spirit upon the meeting. Many good and helpful points were brought out by the different ones in the following program on Sunday-school work:

The Value of the Sunday-school to the Church and the Church to the Sunday-school. - - - O. L. Ruth. The Primary Department of the Sunday-school - W. C. Cruse. Our Young People in Bible Study - Mrs. A. D. Luke. How to Keep Adult Members in the Sunday-school, W. R. Cox. To What Extent Should Missions be Taught in the Sundayschool C. A. Ludwick. The Pastor's Relation to the Sunday-school - M. A. Baldwin. Necessity of Efficient Officials and Teachers - - W. A. Way. The Necessity of Straight and Spiritual Literature

S. M. Stikeleather. The Value of Co-operation with Other Organized Schools. S. S. Nelson.

Thursday 7 A. M.

After prayer the place of the next Conference to be held was put before the house. B. H. Vestal invited the Conference to meet at Winston-Salem, W. R. Cox to Greensboro, and D. C. Siler to Kildee.

Motion was made, seconded and passed to hold the next

Conference at Greensboro, N. C.

Motion was made, seconded and passed that time of Conference to be left to the State Council.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the Minutes of this Conference be published.

Motion made, seconded and passed that S. S. Nelson as-

sist the Sercetary in making out the statistics.

Committee on Beulah Bible School retired for business. Committee conferring with Henry Horton reported that he had two stations in South America and was raising money in United States to build a church in each place, which would cost about \$500 each. He desired all moneys contributed for the same to be sent directly to him, and he would deed the property to the Apostolic Holiness Church, also some personal possessions.

Motion made, seconded and passed to accept this report. Motion made, seconded and passed that Committee or State Superintendent be appointed to meet the Missionary Board at Bi-ennial Assembly and take up the matter of Henry Hor-

ton's work.

Motion made, seconded and passed that Mrs. A. D. Luke go to Cincinnati as a delegate from the Conference.

Motion made, seconded and passed that her Railroad fare

be paid, which was made up in a few minutes.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the appointments of the ministers be read.

1. The Beulah School shall deed its property to the

Apostolic Holiness Conference of N. C.

- 2. Said Conference shall appoint four members of a board of seven, the other three members to be appointed by Beulah Church, which board shall have management of said school.
- 3. Said Conference promises to supply Beulah School with competent teachers, and keep school up to the standard required by Beulah pupils, not exceeding the usual High School course.

4. Beulah promising to finance the school.

5. Conference promises to make necessary improvements as possible to them. This does not include the erection of new buildings.

Motion made, seconded and passed that the report be ac-

Motion made, seconded and passed to adjourn.

W. H. Biller received message urging him to hasten home as his little daughter was at death's door. The Conference led by Mrs. W. R. Cox had special prayer in the behalf of the sick one and also Brother Biller.

REPORT OF THE DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT

I have spent the year in the service of the Lord and for the Church. I have visited all the churches in the district except one. I have held fifteen quarterly meetings. I have held thirteen revivals: six of these being churches in poor circumstances. I have preached 306 sermons; made 308 pastoral calls; seen eighty-eight profess regeneration and thirty-six sanctification. I have written 526 letters in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th quarters. Three churches have been organized for whites and one for colored. Six lots have been secured in N. W. Roanoke for a church and campground. These lots are worth \$1,650. A church is under construction at Christo, Va., and one at Bagley's Swamp, N. C. The Beulah Bible School with a good dormitory and twenty-two acres of land was fin-

ished in being transferred to the Church this year and a a school opened the 4th of October.

I have traveled about 7,000 miles by rail and many miles,

both day and night by buggy, automobile and foot.

I have received from ministers \$302.42. From evangelistic work \$247.61: Other offerings \$138.63. Total offerings from all sources \$688.63. I have spent for conveyance \$161.85. For

rent \$120.00. In the first quarter 29 per cent. of ministers reported. In

second, 88 per cent.. In third, 100 per cent.

Though the gains in numbers and finances have not been large this year, yet the gains have surpassed those of any other year, it has been a year of gains in some of the weak charges.

The field is ripe in this district for workers who are Spirit-filled and are possessed with common sense, wisdom

and energy.
