This Church was started in April 1931 by Rev O D Weaver through cottage Prayer meetings, and preaching in local homes until a building could be rented. Our first location was at 1401 Esplanade St where we worshiped for some time.

This work was carried on for one year as an independent work known as the Pilgrim Gospel Mission.

It was organized one year later into the Pilgrim Holiness Church.
