Brother Bicker took leave of this life on October 24th 1948, at the age of 87 years, a ripe old age. He leaves to mourn his passing, his widowed wife, Mary Bicker, four sons—Earl, Albert, Ralph, and Arthur and one daughter, Mrs. Lydia Olson. Three children preceded him in death, two in infancy, and a son who gave

his life on the missionary field. He also leaves eleven grandchildren, and eleven great-grandchildren.

The funeral services were held October 26, 1948 at 1 p.m. in the Rees Memorial Pilgrim Holiness Church in Pasadena of which he was a member at the time of his death. Rev. Fred K. Wells preached the Funeral message from II Timothy 1:12-"For I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day". Rev.
