The second Annual Conference of the Alabama District of the Pilgrim Holiness Church, convened at the Magnolia Springs Church November 5, 1942 with Rev. R. W. Wolfe, Secretary of General Home Missions in the chair.

The first sitting opened at \$:30 A.M. by singing, "Blest Be the Tie", Prayer was offered by Bro. Wolfe, praying God's special blessing on the work in Ala. Bro. Wolfe then read a Scripture lesson taken from 2 Cor.6:1-10, and gave a vew inspiring message to the workers.

The Secretary then called the roll, Ensley church then presented Mrs. H. Kennedy as lay Delegate.

Magnolia Springs Church then presented Mrs. Frank L. Norris as delegate.

By vote the Conference bar was fixed designating the first four rows of seats.

At this time the Dict. Supt. Hev. W. 2. Honeycutt presented the new church at Megnolia Springs, with 24 members in good and regular standing, as a very splendid addition to the District.

A motion then prevailed to accept this fine church with a rising vote of thanks.

Moved and carried that the Montgomery work be accepted into the District and recorded in our minutes as a mission.

A motion was then made to grant Miss Elizabeth Carr and Mis. Herman Rhyne Deaconess License, carried.

Moved and carried that we have reports at this time beginning with official reports.

Report of Auditor read and accepted. Pastor's report of the Ensley Church read and accepted.

Report of the Magnolia Springs Church read and accepted.

Report of the Pletcher Church read and accepted.

Report of the Lontgomery Lission read and accepted.

Motion to recess until 11:30. Carried.

SECOND SITTING

Second sitting reconvened at 11:30. Report of the Resolutions committee read and accepted.

Bro. Frank L. Horris and Sr. Rachel Carr, both of the Magnolia Springs church, were then presented by the reception committee and were introduced to the conference, each giving a splendid testimony.

A motion made and seconded that the dates of the 1943 Camp and conference be as follows:

Carried.

The Magnolia Springs Church extended to the conference an invitation to hold the camp and conference at Magnolia Springs.

The Invitation was accepted.

Report of the Ways and Means Committee

was read and accepted.

The Minutes of the entire conference was then read and passed upon by the Conference.

A Motion then prevailed and we adjourned. The conference was disnissed in prayer by Rev. Hallie E. Watson.

DIST. SUPT. REFORT.

now in session at Magnolia Springs, Ala. GREFTINGS:

As this brings us to the end of our first complete years work as a District, we look back and find great cause to rejoice in the Lord for all His goodness to us. Inspite of the fact that we are living in a land of death and tragedies, we have only lost one member during the past year by death. Although we have been and are being called upon to make up to the present time, unheard of sacrifice to earry on the program of a Nation engaged in a Global War, yet as a young Dist. we have been enabled to make some gain.

During the past year we have added to our number one new Church at Magnolia Springs with 24 members in good and regular standing, and have been able to do some work in Montgomery, where we have a small but promising Sunday School and regular Services now in progress. Bro, and Sr. Strong, our faithful workers there are carrying on in the face of great difficulties. They are to be commended for their great sacrifice and labor of love.

We wish to submit the following as a summary of our personal labors for the past nine months since our last Conference. I have craamized one church, held one revival, preached 35 times, conducted 30 prayer meetings have made approximately 275 pastoral calls, officiated at one wedding, conducted one funeral, and received into church fellowship 22 new members, I have traveled a total of 15,100 miles including one trip to the Gen Board and on to the General Conference and given all my time to the District Interests. I have received for traveling expense from the Dist. \$3.86 I have received from the District for sup-

port \$131.80. I have received from the General Church 621.00. I have received from the Local church in cash \$121.82. and from the local Church in donations \$225.97, and donations from all other sources \$17.00, making a total salary receipts of \$1131.45.

I have paid my tithe to the Dist. and paid my own traveling expense on the Dist. also \$45.00 on my rent the rest being furnished by the General Church.

I have pastored the Local Church at Magnolia Springs for the past 8 months.
