## REPORT NO. I

### CONFERENCE PRESIDENT'S REPORT

In seeking to broaden the ministry of Wesleyan Methodism among American Negroes I visited the following Conferences; Middle Atlantic States, Rochester, Champlain, Lockport, Michigan, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and Wisconsin.

Quarterly visits were made to the Church at Long. A good spirit was manifested in all of the services.

The Church at Zanesville was visited and Reverend and Mrs. Sanderson are rendering remarkable service and standing true to a holiness witness.

A good group of young people were present at Hillsboro. They deserve our prayers.

The people of Marietta have been quite concerned about the future, due to the fact they have been without a pastor. Brother Odbert Mayle has been pastoring the church in recent months and this seems to be working out very satisfactorily.

It was our privilege to visit Bartlett during an old fashioned revival. The people still have a love for the full gospel.

We found a good attendance at Dayton and an attentive congregation.

We also found a good group at Cutler. Sister Smith, a young pastor, deserves our prayers.

Other services included two Conference Church Extension Board meetings, a Conference Ministerial Meeting, and a Marion College Board meeting.

I was unable to arrange for services in the Tennessee churches.

# THE 71ST ANNUAL SOUTH OHIO CONFERENCE

BARTLETT, OHIO

June 17, 1964

## Wednesday Morning - 9:00 A.M.

Devotions were led by Rev. T. P. Sanderson. Songs - When I See the Blood and I am Thine O Lord were sung. Prayer by Reverend Sanders, Sr. Scripture lesson was taken from 12th Chapter of Romans. Consecration service followed which was led by the President, Rev. Ramsey. Song, Knell at the Cross was then sung followed by prayer around the altar. After a good session at the altar the song "Precious Name" was sung.

The business session was opened by the President Rev. Eugene Ramsey. Reading of the minutes of the last session by Secretary Volorus Chandler. Roll Call of Ministers and Elders followed by the appointment of committees by the President and Vice President. Report of the Credentials and Membership committee was given by Zelicia Smith. The conference body was recessed for 25 minutes for committee work. Reconvened at 11:25 A.M. Report was given by the Rules and Orders Committee chairman, William Jones. Report of the conference president followed. Rev. T. P. Sanderson gave the report of the Vice President. Sunday School Secretary Rev. Elva Johnson then gave her report. Reports of the pastors were given next. Reverend T. P. Sanderson reported for Zanesville, Ohio. Rev. Maxine Smith reported for Cutler, Ohio. We were recessed for lunch.

## Wednesday Afternoon - 2:00 P.M.

Devotions were led by Rev. Maxine Smith. Song "Amazing Grace" Prayer by Rev. Smith. Scripture reading was from the 12th chapter of Jeremiah. Song, Pass Me Not was then sung. Rev. Elva Johnson and Ruth Sanderson were appointed to serve on the Courtesy Committee. Rev. H. H. Sanders, Sr. reported for the W. L. Thompson Memorial and his character was passed from the floor. Joseph King reported for Marietta, Ohio. Rev. Sanders, Jr. reported for Pleasant Hill and Purdy, Tennessee. Report of Finance and Claims committee was given by William Jones. The conference was recessed for committee work at 3:20 P.M.

## Wednesday Evening - 7:30 P.M.

Devotions were led by Frederick Curtis. Song "Pass Me Not" and "Glory to His Name" and "Nothing But the Blood" were sung. We were led in prayer by Rev. Sanderson. Offering was taken by Brother Linzy Stevens and Brother Clarence Croston \$17.21. The message was brought by Reverend Virgil Mitchell on Acts the 5th Chapter. "Getting the Church into Orbit." The sun never goes down on the Wesleyan Methodist work, because they are stationed all around the world carried on by consecrated and dedicated people and he told us about the work at the Publishing Company, and thanked God that the message had gone out and for a spiritual church and for men and women that are holding on to God, we are coming to the zero hour. The church is facing terrible pressure. We must stand steadfast and be at our best in the church. He likened the church to launching a rocket in orbit to show the team work that is needed to obtain the outward and the inward thrust of the gospel and to keep it going to achieve a perfect orbit in the church circle and in the lives of men and women that they might be true witnesses for the Lord and be in tune with God at all times.

He told us about the work of Marion College and the wonderfully dedicated leaders that have gone out from there that are so badly needed. He said if we love the God of Jacob we will have three H's. Help for today. Hope for tomorrow. Happiness all along the way. For God wants to help us in every way. He asked for our help through prayer and funds for the human harvest truly is ripe and we must keep the reapers going out from Marion College.
