## CONFERENCE BUSINESS SESSIONS

Thursday, August 31, 1961-9:00 A.M.

The sixty-eighth annual session of the South Ohio Conference was opened by our conference President, Rev. Eugene Ramsey.

Rev. A.M. Gilmer of Marietta, Ohio led us in devotions and spoke from the 4th Chapter of John. Congregation sang, "O How I Love Jesus" followed by dedication services led by the president.



Rev. Ramsey opened the business session of the 68th annual conference at 9:15 A.M. Program was adopted. Remarks were made by Rev. Gilmer on advertising of the project at Bethel.

Minutes of the 67th annual session were read and adopted. The secretary then called the roll of ministers.

The President, Rev. Ramsey, and the Vice-President, Rev. T.P. Sanderson, appointed the committees. After the appointment the committees were given a 30 minute recess in order to set up their work.

Conference reconvened at 11:00 A.M. at which time Roger Smith was appointed official conference page boy.

Vice President T.P. Sanderson presided as Conference President, Rev. Eugene Ramsey, gave the President's Report. See Report No. 1. Report was adopted.

Rev. T. P. Sanderson, Superannuated Treasurer gave his report. It was adopted. See Report #2.

Brother Lewis Miller gave the report on Credentials. It was adopted. See Report #3.

Due to the absence of Rev. Gertrude Harris, Sunday School secretary, her report will be received by the President and the Advisory board and the secretaries were instructed to send a letter to express our regrets that she cannot be with us.

We were adjourned for lunch by Rev. Mary Howell.

The afternoon session was opened with devotions led by Rev. H. H. Sanders, Sr. He spoke from the 51st Psalm. Congregation sang "Lord I Want to be Like Jesus" followed by Sister Sanderson leading us in prayer.

Minutes of the morning session were read and adopted.

Mrs. Frederick Curtis gave a report on Rev. Gertrude Harris's condition and her letter to the Conference. It was decided by the conference body to send an appropriate gift to Sister Harris as an encouragement to her. We had special prayer for her led by Rev. Ralph Tate.

The committee on Examination of Character Blanks was given by Sister Ruth Sanderson and adopted. See Report #4.

Sister Gertrude Holbert gave the report for her Committee, Moral Reform. It was adopted. See Report #5.

Rev. Ralph Tate gave the Bethel Report.

Conference was given a temporary dismissal while the committees worked.

Reconvened to receive the committee on Courtesy's report. This committee brought a number of people to the Conference to be presented, among them were Rev. Starks and Rev. Sedus Mann and they both gave wonderful testimonies.

Roll Call of Elders was next. Rev. Mann and Rev. Starks were given seats in the Conference Bar.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS followed with Rev. Starks seated in the chair during this period.

Rev. Mary Howell led the evening devotions. Congregation sang "Near the Cross" and "Amazing Grace". Led in Prayer by Rev. Ralph Tate. Then the song "Since I Laid My Burden Down" was sung. Rev. Starks gave a few remarks about his experiences and of this wonderful salvation and about the conditions in Africa. He then presented Rev. Sedu Mann who brought the message from the 20th Chapter of St. John, 21st verse, "Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I You". His topic was "The Witnessing Church". Rev. Mann said, "We must do the will of the Lord while we still have time. It is not in our power but in His power for we have such little time. He urged us to give all to the Lord. Rev. Mann made a plea for Africa because they need friends now. He reminded us of our obligation to our fellowmen.

Song-"Almost Persuaded" was sung and the alter call was given by Rev. Eugene Ramsey. We had a wonderful season of prayer at the altar as the Lord met us there. Song-"Shine On Me". Offering-\$24.81.

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 1961

The Missionary Society meeting gave way for the conference to hold a short business session.

Remarks by Rev. Mitchell. He brought greeting from his fellow workers at Marion, Indiana and spoke of his work and the appreciation of our work.

Appointment of three laymen were made to the Itineracy and Elders Orders committee. Appointment of one layman to the pulpit supply committee to fill the absence of another member.

Business session adjourned and the meeting was turned back to the Missionary Society.

Rev. Odbert Mayle led the devotionals for this session. Songs-"My God Is Real" and "All Along" were sung. We were led in prayer by Rev. Glenn Tabler. "Whispering Hope" and "Keep Me Every Day" were then sung.

Rev. Ramsey, Conference President, gave the call to order.

Secretary read the minutes of the last session and they were approved.

Election of the following committees followed: Sunday School Secretary; Board of Church Extension and Evangelism; Committee on Itineracy and ~~Elders~~ Orders; Committee on Vacancy; Judiciary Board; Nominating committee (which is to elect an alternate to the board of trustees at Marion College); President's Advisory Board (at which time it was decided by the body that one elder and one layman be used); Tithing Secretary; and Magazine Solicitor.

The Courtesy Committee brought Rev. Haywood of Dayton, Ohio and Mrs. Custus of Parkersburg to be introduced to the conference.

We were dismissed for Memorial services. Benediction by Rev. Mitchell. See Report No. 8.

#### SATURDAY AFTERNOON 1:45 P.M.

Devotions for this session were led by Rev. C. A. Pauley of Dayton, Ohio. Congregation sang "I Am Thine O Lord" followed with prayer by Elva Johnson. Song, "Take the Name of Jesus With You" was then sung. Scripture lesson from the 6th Chapter of Jeremiah. Song, "Is Thy Heart Light With God".

The business session was called to order by Rev. Virgil Mitchell.

Rev. Mitchell gave us a run down on the money needed to finance the building fund and a way to raise the money and some explanation on the work of the card call.

#### COMMITTEE ON PASTOR'S CHARACTER BLANKS REPORTED.

Treasurer's report was given by Rev. C. C. Pauley.

We had a special prayer for the healing of Cynthia Ramsey who was ill with a heart condition.

Report of Hillsboro, Ohio church by Rev. Rita Lee.

There was a discussion on the Hillsboro Church and the placing of Rev. Rita Lee. We had a special prayer on this matter and it was placed in the hands of the conference body and they decided to send Rev. Rita Lee back to Hillsboro for another year.

It was decided to change the date of the Conference to meet the third Wednesday in June.

It was put to the body that the Sunday School Convention meet at the same time as the Conference next year. After some discussion it was decided to hold it in August.

The Courtsey Committee presented Rev. Howard Noggle to the conference and he gave us a few words of encouragement by way of testimony.

The President appointed the Committee on Committees.

Report of Deaconess Elva Johnson was received. 1  
Report of Deaconess Thereasa Clark was received.  
Mr. and Mrs. James Wilson were presented to the  
Conference.

Adjourned to meet again at the call of the Chair.
